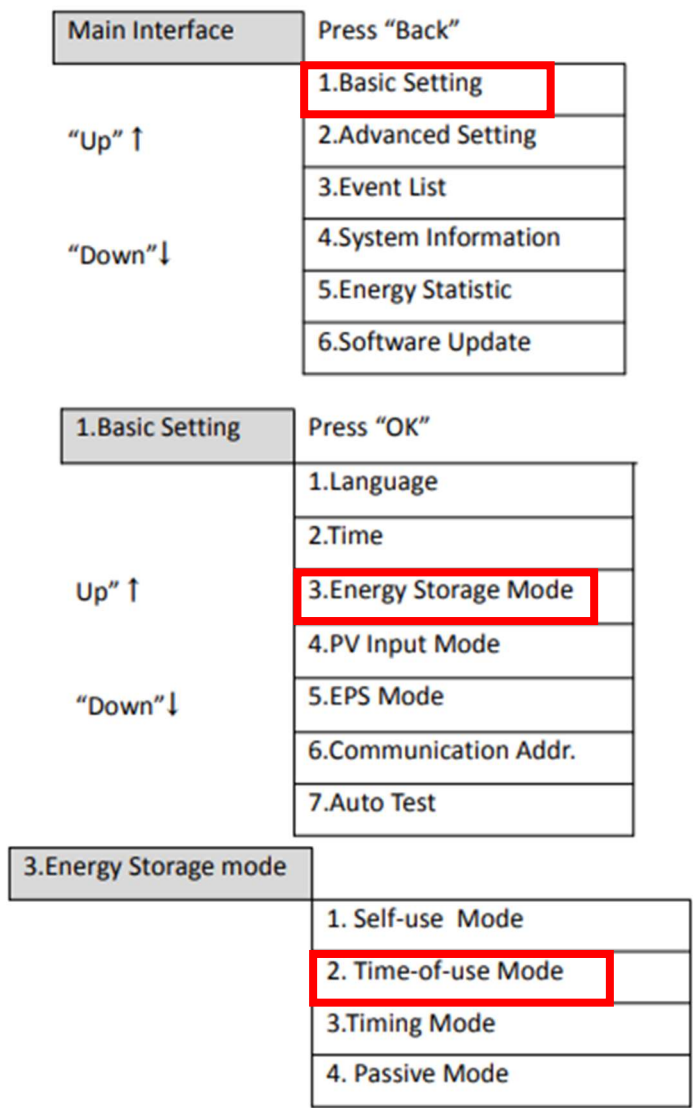


# Time of Use - Sofar Hybrid Inverters

Time of Use enables you to selectively charge batteries from the grid. This is a useful option for people who have a flexible energy tariff, to charge the batteries overnight when electricity from the grid can be purchased cheaply. This is often useful in winter, to maximise returns from your battery system.

1. Approach Hybrid Inverter
  - a. This will be the inverter that is wired directly to your batteries
2. Press any button on the faceplate of the inverter to bring up the backlight
3. Press the leftmost (“Back”) button to enter the “Main Menu”
4. Navigate the following (using the rightmost (“Enter”) button to enter a directory):

At this screen, you can set and enable rules.

Outside of the times defined in the rule(s), the system will operate under self-use prioritisation as normal.

In general, the hours of cheapest power are between 00:30 and 04:30, do check under the details of your tariff.

SOC stands for state of charge. The charge (battery charge power) can be set up to 2800W.
